

Notice of Disclosure of Potential Non-Public Transmission Function Information

Consumers Energy Company, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 358.7(a)(2), provides notice that it, as a Transmission Provider, inadvertently disclosed information that may be considered non-public Transmission Function Information to one of its Marketing Function Employees on October 14, 2016. It is not clear at this point whether the information is definitively Transmission Function Information, but Consumers Energy is treating it as such in the interests of prudence. In addition, the information is considered confidential Critical Energy Infrastructure Information, as defined in 18 C.F.R. § 388.113(c)(1). As such, under 18 C.F.R. § 358.7(a)(2), Consumers Energy provides this Notice of Disclosure that this potential non-public Transmission Function Information was disclosed.

All capitalized terms in this Notice of Disclosure are, except where noted, defined in 18 C.F.R. § 358.3.
