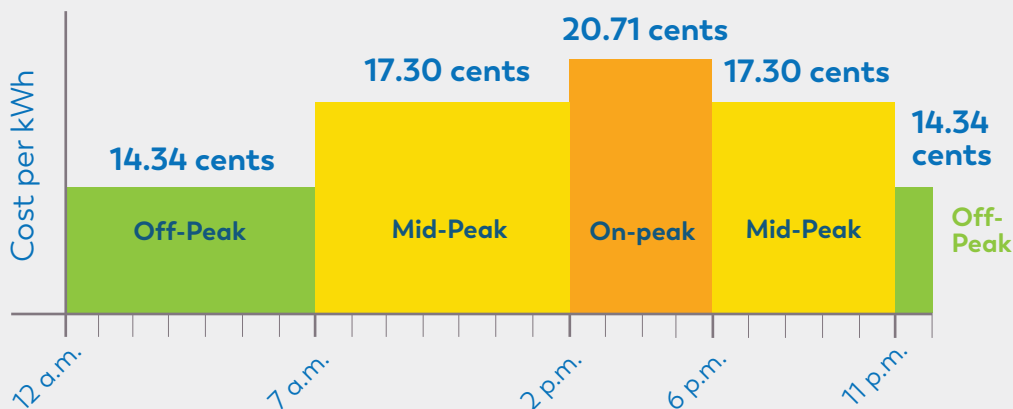

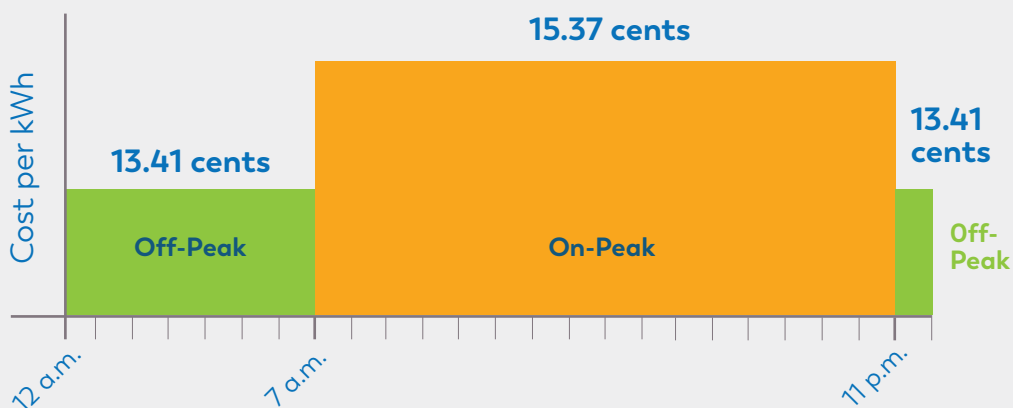
Winter | January - May / October - December

11 p.m. to 7 a.m.

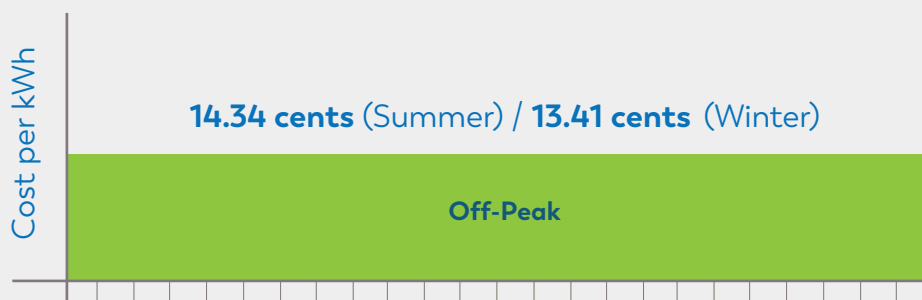

The following schedule shall apply Monday through Friday (except holidays designated by the Company): New Year's Day - January 1; Memorial Day - Last Monday in May; Independence Day - July 4; Labor Day - First Monday in September; Thanksgiving Day - Fourth Thursday in November; and Christmas Day - December 25. Whenever January 1, July 4 or December 25 fall on a Sunday, extended holiday periods such as Monday, January 2, Monday, July 5 and Monday, December 26 shall not be considered as holidays for application of off-peak hours.

Prices per kilowatt hour are rounded to the nearest hundredth of the cent. Rates shown do not include all applicable surcharges or taxes. Rates may change by Michigan Public Service Commission Order.
