Since its opening in 1930, designed by Maurice Herman Finkel and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Michigan Theatre has been a sanctuary of entertainment.

The Michigan Theatre of Jackson Inc., a not-for-profit Michigan corporation, acquired the building from the City of Jackson in 1993. The group continues to restore and operate the theatre, bringing in classic films, art films, live theatre productions, concerts, meetings, and other community events. The project will finally transform downtown Jackson's sleeping beauty into a major attraction for the entire region.


