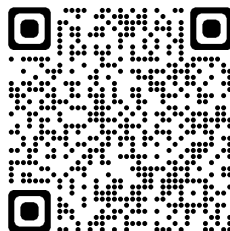
Food: All-You-Can-Eat Brunch Buffet

need to arrive between 9:45 & 10:00am.



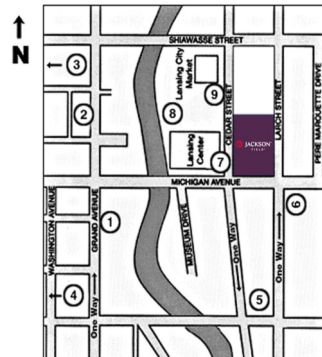

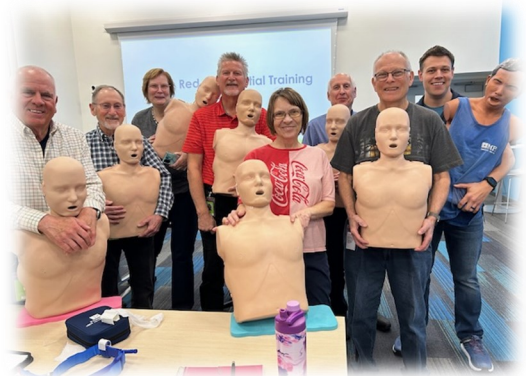
