The Hanover-Horton Area Historical Society, located at 105 Fairview St, Hanover, is a hidden gem for history enthusiasts and music lovers alike. With a collection of over 100 restored antique reed pump organs, the Conklin Reed Organ Museum offers a unique auditory experience, allowing visitors to hear the rich sounds of the past. The museum also houses a variety of local and general historical artifacts, providing a comprehensive look into the local

heritage. A guided tour by a knowledgeable docent, complemented by live demonstrations from an organist, makes for an educational and enjoyable visit. The museum's location, with parking available at the rear on Tefft Street, and the affordable entry fee of \$10 per person, makes it an accessible and inviting destination for those looking to explore the musical and historical treasures of Hanover. After delving into the past, guests can continue their day with a leisurely lunch and a friendly game of Euchre at the Deer Run Restaurant, located at 3200 Hanover Road, where the camaraderie and cuisine are sure to be as memorable as the museum tour.


