- A high school graduate holding a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Graduate must supply a high school transcript
- Committed to pursuing a full-time academic program.
- Entering their first year at a post-secondary educational institution or trade school.
- The recipient of only one scholarship per year from a Forerunner member.
- Associated with a Forerunner member whose dues are up to date.
