

### Message from: Consumers Energy Volunteer Investment Program

Have you volunteered in your community or made charitable donations to nonprofit organizations this year? Don't forget to log your volunteer hours and donation receipts in the CE Volunteer Portal. December 13 is the last day to redeem 2024 volunteer grants and Matching Gifts.

#### Volunteer Investment Program (VIP)

Nonprofit organizations depend on volunteers to make their missions come to life, and the Consumers Energy Foundation is here to support the incredible work #CEVolunteers are doing in the community. One way the Foundation supports nonprofits is through the Volunteer Investment Program. When you volunteer 20+ hours in your community and log those hours in the CE Volunteer Portal you'll become eligible for grant dollars that can be designated to a U.S.-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit of your choice. This could be the organization you volunteer with, or a different organization—you decide!

#### **Matching Gift Program**

Did you know that individual contributions you make to eligible nonprofits may be doubled through our Foundation's Matching Gifts program? Tax deductible charitable donations of \$25 or more may be matched dollar-for-dollar up to a combined total of \$1,000 per retiree in a calendar year.

The benefitting organization must be a U.S.-based non-profit organization with 501(c)(3) tax status. Other organizations, including public schools, that qualify for funding through the Consumers Energy Foundation may also be eligible. Donations made to religious organizations will only qualify for a match if the donation supports a public-facing program that is not focused on furthering a religious faith (eligible examples include food pantries and church-sponsored child care). This program must be specified within your Matching Gift application. Make a personal charitable donation and apply for a match using the CF Volunteer Portal.
